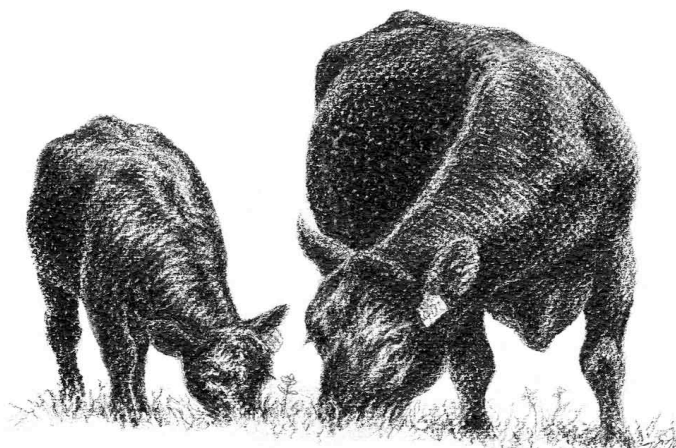


# 2017 Cape Fear Regional Cattle Conference
